Montana Republican Presidential Caucus To Be Held In February of 2008

On August 25th, the Republican State central Committee approved by a 72 to 14 vote a change to the Party Rules, providing for a Republican Presidential Caucus. The caucus will be conducted on the evening of February 5, 2008, which is Super Tuesdays. This event will be at a yet to be announced local venue. Republicans eligible to vote are all state and county elected officials, and all state and county Central Committee members. Gallatin County Central Committee members include all elected officers, precinct committeemen and committeewomen. Vacant precinct positions that are filled by appointment 45 days prior will be eligible to vote at the caucus. The results of the statewide caucus shall be binding on the first ballot at the Republican National Convention in Minneapolis in September of 2008. There are still a few precincts with open seats.
